### District's history to be preserved in 'Idukki Shelf'

WITH A collection of over 15,000 books, the shelves of Nelumkandam MES College library are rich in history and culture spanning decades.

However, its legacy does not stop there. Since 2016, the library has been offering a separate space for books on the history of the Idukki district to protect these books from erosion, which they have named as 'Idukki Shelf'.

Today, the library operates as a research space for history buffs from outside the state and a gathering space for aficionados.

'Idukki Shelf' comprises books on various genres, including history books, souvenirs of churches, periodicals, memoirs, newspaper clippings, travelogues, legal publications and pictures of great historical significance and value.

Among them, 36 photographs on historical places, persons and things concerning Idukki was contributed by Jayakumar, assistant professor at NRS College, Cherthala.

"These done by UG and PG students of the department of history contributed a lot to the reference library. The process of acquisition of documents to the library is continuing and the project reports by students are regularly adding into it," college principal M A Rasheed said.

The collection includes 'Kallar Patton Colony History' by C Sejeev, 'Eghuranginte Kudiyetta Charitram' by Fr K J Kurias and a copy of the 30-year-old 'Periyar Lake Lease Agreement' which was signed between Mahatma of Tirunelveli and the Secretary of State for India for the Periyar irrigation works.

### Low-cost irrigation technique helps cardamom farmer reap bumper crop

By using a low-cost irrigation technique, a cardamom farmer in Idukki district has reaped a bumper crop. The farmer, who has been using the technique for several years, has reported a significant increase in yield and quality of his produce. The technique involves using a simple system of pipes and pumps to deliver water directly to the plants, reducing water wastage and ensuring that the plants receive the right amount of water at the right time. This has helped the farmer to overcome the challenges of irregular rainfall and drought conditions in the region.
